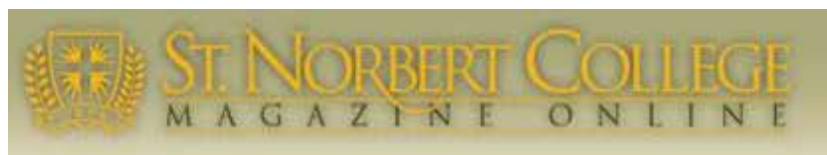

Laurie MacDiarmid and her daughter Lizzie blog from Manila

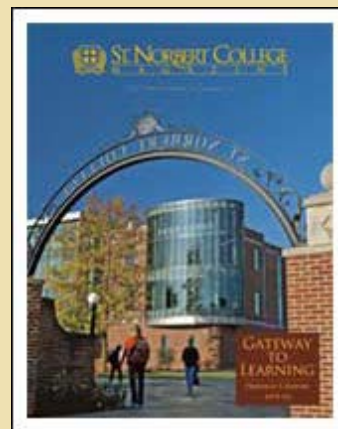
The great thing about selecting your writer-in-residence for an exchange semester is that it's easy for the rest of the world to follow right along.
