

While You're Visiting

Lost Dauphin Park sits less than five miles south of campus. It boasts rolling hiking trails, picnic facilities, a beautiful view of the Fox River and an intriguing backstory.

The 19-acre parcel was once part of missionary Eleazer Williams' homestead. In 1841, Williams claimed to be the Lost Dauphin: the son of King Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette, who were executed in 1793 during the French Revolution. Official accounts said their son, heir to the throne, died in captivity in 1795. But rumors persisted he had escaped.
