# A Checklist of Prose Works by George MacDonald in Victorian Periodicals and Newspapers

Richard I. Johnson

The purpose of this bibliography is to provide as complete a list as possible of the prose works of George MacDonald (GMD) that appeared in Victorian periodicals and newspapers. The digitization of 19th century material on the internet now provides the possibility of significantly adding to the items mentioned in the bibliographies of Bulloch and Shaberman, especially with respect to regional newspapers and newspapers published in the colonies (notably Australia).

Such a project can never be guaranteed to be complete, but I hope it has reached a stage where it can be of real value to librarians, collectors, and researchers.

It is especially useful in tracing the literary history of a novel such as *Donald Grant*, which was published in both a long edition (mostly in the US) and a short edition (mostly in the UK). It has often been assumed that this novel was never serialized; but in fact it appeared in serial form in 6 different newspapers (3 in Great Britain and 3 in Australia), and always in the long edition (thus confirming the precedence of the long edition over the short); but it should be noted that even this “long” text has often been edited, sometimes quite significantly, in the different newspapers. The information given in this bibliography should prove useful as a starting point for further research in this area.

For each item I have given the periodical/newspaper title, the volume and part number (where applicable), the date of publication, the pages on which the GMD material appears, and, in the case of serialized stories, details of which chapters were included in each issue.

In addition, where chapter divisions in serializations differ from those in the subsequently published book, I have noted [in square brackets] the equivalent chapters in the first UK one-volume edition of the book. (I assume that most readers—such as myself!—are more likely to have access to the one-volume editions than the triple-deckers.) Where the section begins or ends in the middle of a chapter I have also given the equivalent page numbers in the book. (I have not, for reasons of space, indicated precisely where on

each page the division was made.)

Thus, for example, in the *Glasgow Weekly Mail* serialization of *Donal Grant*, there is the line:

1102 (7 Apr 1883) p7 (ch 18-19) [14-15 / 287-305]

This means that in issue number 1102, dated 7th Apr 1883, there is what the newspaper identifies as ch 18-19 on page 7. However, the square brackets indicate that in the published book (long edition) the equivalent section of text includes parts of ch 14 and 15, and runs from pages 287-305.

It should be noted that the book form is often longer than the serialization. Sometimes GMD added material before the novel was published in book form (notably in the case of *Robert Falconer* and *Home Again*), but frequently newspaper editors removed or abbreviated some of the text that had been sent to them. For example, in the 30 June 1883 issue of the *Glasgow Weekly Mail*, what became 83 pages (p588-671) in the book version of *Donal Grant* is abbreviated into 4 columns on one page! (Because of the small size of print each column is roughly equivalent to 5-6 pages.) This is not a case of GMD expanding the story later, as the other newspapers which serialized the story did not abbreviate this section in the same way; the *Manchester Weekly Post*, for example, spreads the same material over 4 weeks. It would be fascinating to know exactly what text was sent to the newspapers and what their reasons were for editing it!

Observant readers will notice that in the Australian serializations there are occasional weeks with no material. This occurs when they have run out of text, which was sent to them a section at a time; thus in the *Queenslander*, on 10th Mar 1883 (p365) we read, “We have to apologise for the absence of ‘Donal Grant’ from this issue, our supply of ‘copy’ having run out. By the incoming English mail, no doubt, a further instalment will arrive.” Indeed, it did; over the next two weeks ch 3 is serialized; but then there is a further gap before ch 4 appears. Given that it took about 50 days to make the sea journey from England to Australia, it may well be possible to calculate the approximate rate at which GMD was writing, or at least sending, the early stages of this story.


The bibliography itself is in chronological order, whilst keeping complete serializations together. For ease, I have converted all Roman numerals to their Arabic equivalents, and I have excluded words such as “continued” or “concluded” from the chapter headings.

With rare exceptions, I have not included written accounts in newspapers of GMD's sermons and talks.

I have not indicated the source of my information for each entry, but the main websites I have used have been Internet Archive, HathiTrust, the British Newspapers Archive, Newspapers.com, Welsh Newspapers Online, and Trove (for Australian papers). I am also grateful to the librarians of the British Library, the Mitchell Library in Glasgow, Cambridge University Library and Manchester Central Library for providing access to material that has not yet been digitized.

In addition particular thanks for their help are due to Barbara Amell; Jack Ennis Butler, National Library of Australia; Gabrielle Christiansen, Chicago History Museum Research Center; Karen Corbett, Bangor Public Library; Rachel Johnson, for visiting Cambridge University Library for me; Elizabeth Millar, Mount Allison University; Laurie Rossi, John Hay Library; Jacqueline Vigilante, for visiting Manchester Central Library for me; and to my brother Peter Johnson, for paying for my accommodation during my visit to the Mitchell Library, Glasgow.

In the *Monthly Christian Spectator* for 1853 and 1854 there were several short stories translated from the German, with no indication of the translator. Some of the phraseology sounds very much like GMD (e.g. “the Heavenly Father of the fatherless”), but without further evidence it would be impossible to be sure that he was the translator. In case others can shed further light on the matter, the following four issues contain these translations:

**Robert Falconer** [letter]

The letter reads: “July 28, 1868. Will you allow me to make a statement concerning a matter somewhat affecting my literary reputation? When the closing portion of my story called “Robert Falconer” appeared in the *Argosy* last November, I appended a note to the effect that want of space had interfered with its completeness, but that it would be published in full afterwards. In the month of June it was brought out in three volumes by Messrs, Hurst and Blackett. Of this issue a fourth part is entirely new matter, while the amount of alteration would almost justify the statement that the story had been rewritten. It is not, then, altogether pleasant to find that one of the principal libraries is supplying, as “Robert Falconer,” the monthly parts cut out of the *Argosy*, and bound by themselves.

Have I not a right, with your permission, to inform any of your readers, who may be my readers as well that I altogether refuse to have the work judged by that adumbration of it which appeared in the *Argosy*.

“Then you’re leaving the story unfinished, Mr. Editor!”

“Not more unfinished than a story ought to be, I hope. If you ever knew a story finished, all I can say is, I never did. Somehow stories won’t finish. I think I know why, but I won’t say that either now.”



The publishers faced criticism for serializing this story several years after it was published; for example, the *South Australian Register* for 21 Nov 1884 (p5) comments, “we fail to see the object of reprinting George MacDonald’s ‘Mary Marston,’ a well-known story, which has been in the hands of the public in book-form for some considerable time.”; and the *Express and Telegraph*, Adelaide (24 Nov 1884 p2) wrote: “We should have thought...that it would not have been difficult for the proprietors to secure plenty of literary talent capable

of writing a fairly good original novel instead of falling back on one of Mr George MacDonald's, which is already perfectly familiar to readers of that class of literature." The publishers persevered for another year but at the end of ch 21 there is the following note: "The story of Mary Marston will be condensed and concluded in our next." In the next issue, the text is presented as "Abridged and concluded."
