### Alum steps up to the plate at women's series

Milwaukee Brewers vice president and general counsel **Marti Wronski '94** is batting third in the 2011-12 Women's Enrichment Series. She'll present "There's No Crying in Baseball" at 12 noon on Friday, Nov. 18, in the Hendrickson Dining Room of the F.K. Bemis International Center.

Wronski just finished her eighth season with the Brewers, and her sixth in her current role. In it, she oversees all legal and contract work, including players' and coaches' contracts, sponsorship contracts, legal designs for trademark and fan entertainment, and compliance matters.

Prior to joining the Brewers, Wronski worked from 1997 to 2001 as a litigation associate in the Milwaukee office of Foley & Lardner. She also served as an assistant professor at Marquette University Law School for the 2002-03 academic year.
